



**CRITERIA FOR SELECTION
OF PAPERS AND POSTERS**
ICOM-CC 18th Triennial Conference
Copenhagen, Denmark
4–8 September 2017

Papers and poster abstracts will be ranked according to the following criteria:

- O) Originality and innovation of the work presented (Does it advance the field? Has this work been published before in substantially the same form?)
- A) Application to conservation practice (Practicality of application? Who can use the results of this work?)
- T) Technical merit (Are the conclusions of the paper/poster valid? Does it reach a conclusion?)
- R) Relevance to Working Group aims/triennial program (For details, see: www.icom-cc.org/9/working-groups/)
- S) Logical Structure, good argumentation and clear writing style (This relates to organization of content, not to author's proficiency in the English language.)
- C) Demonstration of Collaboration between disciplines (e.g. conservation, science, art history, humanities) or of public engagement

Criteria O), A) and T) may be assigned points from 0 – 8:
0 (does not apply), 2 (poor), 4 (fair), 6 (good), 8 (excellent)

Criteria R), S) and C) may be assigned points from 0 – 4:
0 (does not apply), 1 (poor), 2 (fair), 3 (good), 4 (excellent)

The total score for all criteria will be between 0 and 36.
